Endoscopic Masterclass

Zealand University Hospital, Køge, Denmark

Purpose

We offer a two-day masterclass based on the daily procedures in a large endoscopic ward at a university hospital. We will focus on rendezvous ERCP in continuation of the new, national, clinical guideline for treatment of symptomatic gallbladder disease.

Overview

The Endoscopic department at Zealand University Hospital, Køge, has an extensive endoscopic production, performing over 12,000 endoscopic procedures a year, including: Gastrosopies with therapy, e.g. peg tubes, banding, stents, ERCP with therapy including rendezvous and SPY. Colonoscopies with therapy, e.g. EMR, ESD, e-FTR and ECT. EUS, diagnostic and therapeutic, single ballon enteroscopy and symptomatic gallbladder disease.

Number of participants

In order to ensure interactivity between faculty and attendees, the number of participants is restricted to 20.

Program

See a wide range of procedures carried out by the department on a daily basis. From gastroscopies and colonoscopies with therapy to EUS and therapeutic ERCP. In particular we will focus on rendezvous ERCP. There will be something for everyone, regardless of experience level.

There will be a high degree of interaction between lecturers, staff and course participants. All live procedures will be transmitted to the auditorium with a direct audio connection to the endoscopy room. You can also choose to be present in the endocopy room.

Rendezvous ERCP

We have invited **Fredrik Swahn** to speak about rendezvous ERCP on Thursday evening. (Fredrik Swahn: MD, PhD, GI-Endoscopy, Upper abdominal unit, Comprehensive Cancer Centre, Karolinska University Hospital, Stockholm). During the last 18 years, Fredrik Swahn has worked on developing and refining rendezvous ERCP techniques. Today, more than 80 % of all departments performing gallbladder surgery in Sweden use rendezvous when treating patients for gallstones.
